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Making Sundays Special

Or bake a yummy dessert that you eat on Sunday night. Perhaps you want to have a snack supper of popcorn, cheese, crackers, fruit and veggies while watching a family movie. Or make homemade pizzas.

Keep special art supplies, a box of toys or games that ONLY comes out on Sunday afternoons.

Acts of service: Can Sundays be a day you make cards for people? Call grandparents or friends? Check on neighbours?

Décor: There are so many lovely pieces of artwork that depict Bible scenes. Print a new one out each Sunday. Enjoy it throughout the week and anticipate what next Sunday's picture will be.
