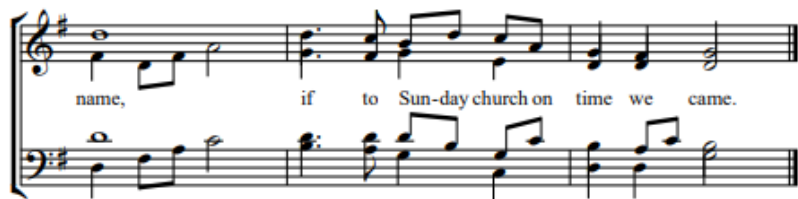
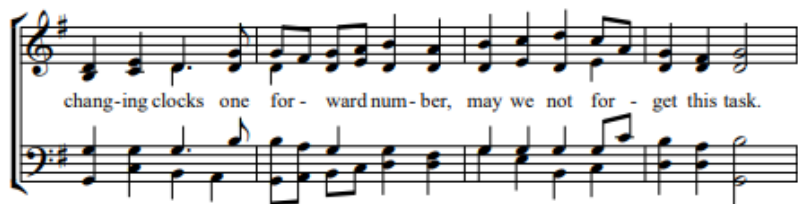
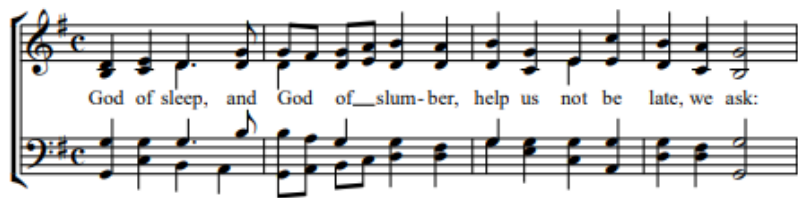

We will be having our **Annual General Meeting** on **Saturday, March 27, 2021 at 7:00pm.**

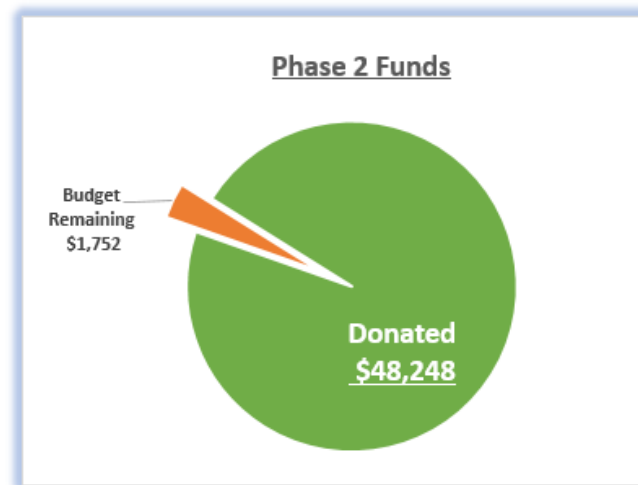
All are welcome to attend, however only members of GBC will be able to vote.

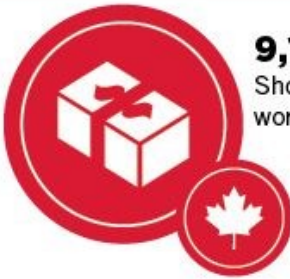
This phase to be voted on at the annual congregational meeting.

### Seeking prayer for healing and comfort from illness or pain:

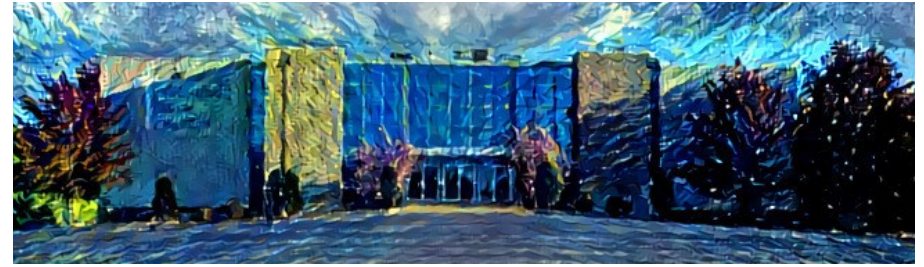
- \* Gilles Groleau's daughter, Chantal's father-in-law Pierre. Dealing with aggressive cancer.
