Nebuchadnezzar the king to all the peoples, nations, and populations of all languages who live in all the earth: "May your peace be great! I am pleased to declare the signs and miracles that the Most High God has done for me. How great are His signs and how mighty are His miracles! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And His dominion is from generation to generation.

"I, Nebuchadnezzar, was at ease in my house and happy in my palace. I saw a dream and it startled me; and these appearances as I lay on my bed and the visions in my mind kept alarming me. So I gave orders to bring into my presence all the wise men of Babylon, so that they might make known to me the interpretation of the dream. The animals of the field found shade under it, And the birds of the sky lived in its branches, And all living creatures fed from it.

'I was looking in the visions in my mind as I lay on my bed, and behold, an angelic watcher, a holy one, descended from heaven. He shouted out and spoke as follows:

"Chop down the tree and cut off its branches, Shake off its foliage and scatter its fruit; Let the animals flee from under it

and the birds from its branches. Yet leave the stump with its roots in the ground, But with a band of iron and bronze around it In the new grass of the field; And let him be drenched with the dew of heaven, And let him share with the animals in the grass of the earth.

Let his mind change from that of a human And let an animal's mind be given to him, And let seven periods of time pass over him.

This sentence is by the decree of the angelic watchers, And the decision is a command of the holy ones, In order that the living may know That the Most High is ruler over the realm of mankind, and He grants it to whomever He wishes And sets over it the lowliest of people."
