- Next Steps program (provides a safe space for those who are street adjacent to take their Next Steps) grew substantially and served many.
- Enhance (serves youth who have come to Thunder Bay for high school) has become more consistent, interwoven with other programs.
- The Gathering continues with an attendance of 70-80 each Sunday. People have come to faith in Jesus, and many are being discipled.
- The Learning Centre and Bible Studies Influx of students learning God's Word, supporting one another, and looking outward to care about others.
- · Two new counselling students have joined for their internship.
- The Community Care team has built new relationships with those living in the low-income complexes encouraging participation in family day camps, monthly Family Events and the Gathering.
- Financial struggles were met providing needed day-to-day funds as well as funds for projects:
- the washer/dryer project.
- One hundred individual Christmas gifts were purchased plus many hand-made quilts made wonderful gifts for families.
- Only \$10,000 more is needed to purchase the 15 seat Van (for Elders and children)

Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and was full of violence. God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on earth had corrupted their ways.

So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth. So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out. This is how you are to build it: The ark is to be three hundred cubits long, fifty cubits wide and thirty cubits high. Make a roof for it, leaving below the roof an opening one cubit high all around. Put a door in the side of the ark and make lower, middle and upper decks. I am going to bring floodwaters on the earth to destroy all life under the heavens, every creature that has the breath of life in it.

You are to take every kind of food that is to be eaten and store it away as food for you and for them."

Noah did everything just as God commanded him.

The Lord then said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and your whole family, because I have found you righteous in this generation. Take with you seven pairs of every kind of clean animal, a male and its mate, and one pair of every kind of unclean animal, a male and its mate, and also seven pairs of every kind of bird, male and female, to keep their various kinds alive throughout the earth. Seven days from now I will send rain on the earth for forty days and forty nights, and I will wipe from the face of the earth every living creature I have made."
