²⁶ Look at the birds of the air, that they do not sow, nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not worth much more than they?


Truth for Teens - Ozzie's Pantry


Also, at the back table are shoeboxes for you to take and fill along with labels and guides on what to fill them with.


