- Thanks from Anna Hildebrant for those praying for her family and her brother-in-law.

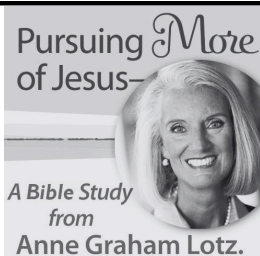
Requests for Prayer

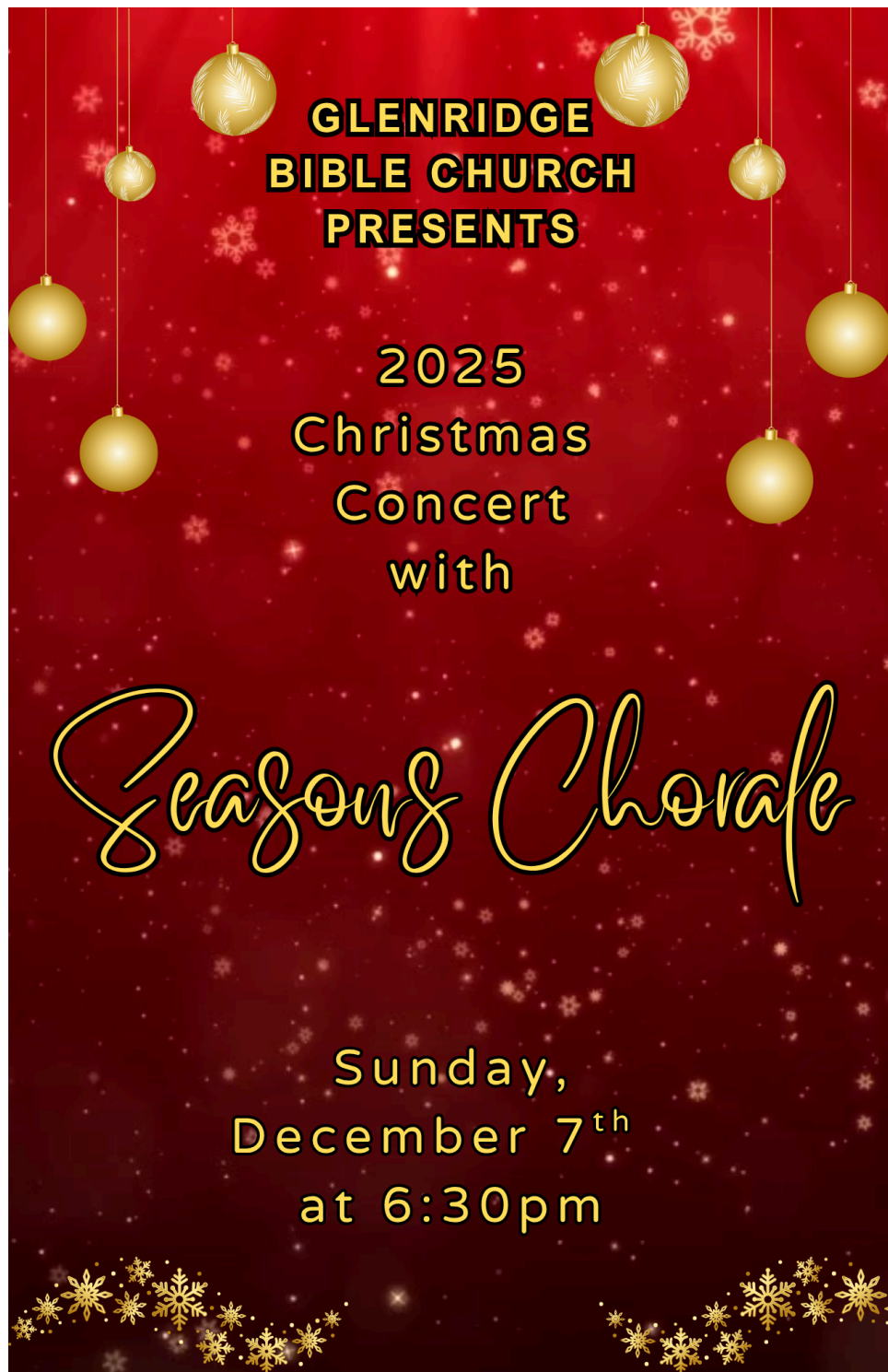
